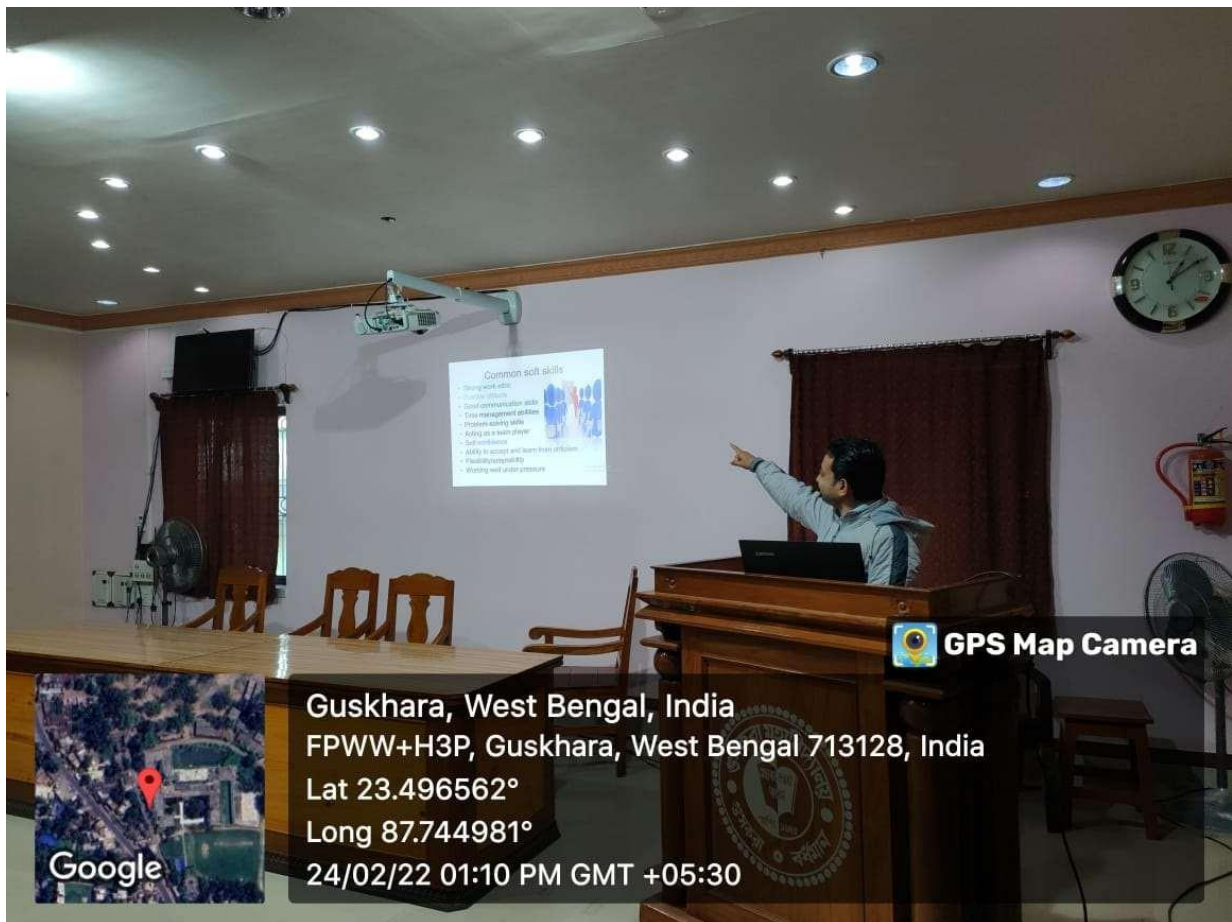

In addition to non-verbal communication, the seminar also focused on enhancing students' verbal communication skills. Active listening, articulation, and persuasive speaking were highlighted as key components of effective communication. Students were encouraged to actively engage in discussions, debates, and presentations to practice and refine these skills.

The college acknowledges that soft skills encompass more than just body language and communication. Therefore, the seminar also covered other important aspects such as teamwork, problem-solving, and leadership. Students were encouraged to participate in group activities, where they could develop their teamwork and collaboration skills. They were also exposed to problem-solving techniques and encouraged to think critically and creatively.

To ensure personalized attention and guidance, through the introduction of Mentor-Mentee concept; particularly in Corona period the college offers mentoring sessions to students.
